A pink-collar worker is someone working in career fields historically considered to be women's work. This includes many clerical, administrative, and service jobs as well as care-oriented jobs in therapy, nursing, social work, teaching or child care. While these jobs may also be filled by men, they have historically been female-dominated (a tendency that continues today, though to a somewhat lesser extent) and may pay significantly less than white-collar or blue-collar jobs.

Women's work - notably with the delegation of women to particular fields within the workplace - began to rise in the 1940s, in concurrence with World War II.

On July 13, 2013, he was acquitted of second-degree murder in Florida v. George Zimmerman. After his acquittal, Zimmerman was the target of a shooting stemming as part of a road rage incident, the perpetrator of which was convicted of attempted murder.

After the shooting, Zimmerman generated controversy for his social media activity, including his paintings of the Confederate flag and a number of other statements described as racist and Islamophobic, including calling a bar owner a "nigger-lover" according to Florida police.

Occupational licensing, also called licensure, is a form of government regulation requiring a license to pursue a particular profession or vocation for compensation. It is related to occupational closure.

Some claim higher public support for the licensing of professions whose activities could be a health or safety threat to the public, such as practicing medicine, and doctors require

occupational licenses in most developed countries. However, some jurisdictions also require licenses for a much wider range of professions, such as florists and hairdressers. Some studies find consumers are more responsive to reviews than to occupational licensing status.

Licensing creates a regulatory barrier to entry into licensed occupations. Licensing advocates argue that it protects the public interest by...
